Guidelines for Submission of Articles and Research Papers

- All article / research papers must be typed in Times New Roman, Font Size 12, in double spacing (for English) and Kruti Dev 010, Font Size 14, in double spacing (for Hindi)
- Article / research papers must have proper referencing using latest APA referencing style. All references should be given at the end of the paper.
- All article / research papers will undergo a peer review process for selection
- Manuscripts should preferably be between 3000 and 5000 words (including quotations, foot notes and references) with one-inch margin on all sides.
- It should include on a separate page, abstract of about 500 words and a short professional resume of the author, giving name, position, institution, office and email address.
- Selected full length articles/research papers would be considered for publication in a UGC listed Journal following the guidelines of the Journal.
- Research Paper or Article should be original work of the author and no sort of plagiarism should be present in the paper.
